Your Next Appointment:

The health of our patients and staff is our top priority. We follow the CDC's recommendations and guidelines, and any rules implemented by Tallahassee Memorial Healthcare. Due to the Coronavirus pandemic, at this time **patients scheduled for gynecological visits may not bring guests and children are not permitted inside the practice.** Obstetrical patients are only permitted one guest over 18 years of age. Patients who arrive with children or other guests not permitted will be rescheduled and are subject to the practice's cancellation policy. Children and guests may not remain in the reception area during patients' appointments.

Please do not arrive sick! If you have an upcoming appointment with us and you are running a fever or are experiencing any other COVID-related symptoms, please call us and we will be happy to reschedule your appointment.

Masks or face coverings are mandatory at Gynecology & Obstetrics Associates of Tallahassee. Per office policy, ALL people - sick or well – are required to use face coverings inside the practice and must submit to a temperature check. Any person entering the premises is required to arrive wearing their face covering. Please note, **your mouth and nose** must remain **completely covered at all times** within the practice for the entire duration of the visit. No exceptions will be made.
